## FOOD SAFETY

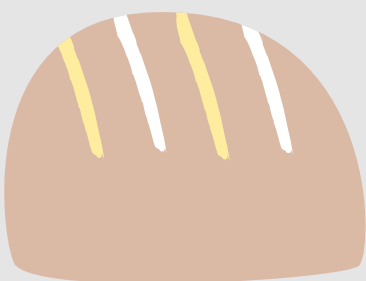

Communion Servers will continue to practice recommended hand hygiene, including washing their hands with soap and water and using hand sanitizer prior to handling the bread and wine.



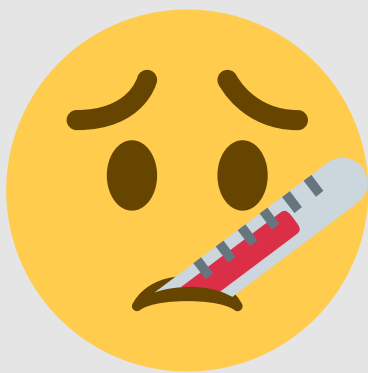
